INTRODUCTION

In the Spring of 2023 Judy and I were asked to catalog a number of items which were being kept in the safe that was becoming overcrowded. These records begin with the journals of Nathan Rathbun covering the period 1817 – 1849.

Under the auspices of Rev. Chris Leudde and Parishioner Richard Hagy the historical documents were microfilmed (April, 1990). This film roll is item #0005 and covers the period 1817 ending with Record Book (marriages) 1987 – 1989. This film record was digitized in September 2015. This digitized record appear on item #0004td(SAFE), a **USB thumb drive** (Blue hptm – 16GB) and on item #0004-M

For this inventory, no attempt was made to rank the items in chronological or logical order. One exception are the 4 Parish Cash Books covering Jan-1927 through Dec-19502, #0036 - #0039. Recording and indexing was done on a “first picked-up basis”. An “executive decision” was made not to discard anything. Hence, there will be multiple copies of some items like directories. See, for instance, #0189 through #0189.5. Some Vestry Minutes are recorded in ledgers, and some are loose. Often, some records were not identified with a date. This is probably the most egregious sin found followed by formal documents without dates and photographs lacking the identity of the people shown or the nature of the event being recorded.

In the future if any items are discarded, a note mut be made in this record.

The following inventory record consists of four columns describing the item:

1. Number a sequential assigned to each item. The location, SAFE or LIBRARY, is shown. Obviously, the location may be changed at any time, but it must be recorded.
2. Item a somewhat feeble attempt to describe the physical item. Terms such as Folder, Ledger, Binder, Box, and Notebook appear. Some items are stored in boxes. See Boxes under Technical Data below for a size description and alphabetical designation.
3. Date Inclusive dates of the item, when available.
4. Contents A short recitation of the contents of the item.

The Number and Contents appear on labels affixed to the item whenever possible. See for instance #0171 through #0176 where the label is attached to the reverse side of the identification card.

The diligence of record keeping in the past varies. No attempt was made to quantify this. Quite by accident it was noted that the Marriage Record on page 124 of #0016 is missing the date. Handwriting in the various documents and Parish Registers ranges from nearly unreadable to fantastic calligraphy. One can find some remarkably clear script and some calligraphic printing offset by some nearly unreadable scrawl.

Labels


Labels used are 1" x 2-5/8" Rectangle Labels, WeatherProof White Film for Laser, Avery 5160. Labels are covered with 2" x 4" Glossy Clear Shipping Labels, Avery 6522. The adhesive on the small labels seems to be secure on most surfaces. The adhesive on the clear covering labels may not be as permanent as hoped, especially on the fabric-like covering on some of the ledgers. Only time will tell. The information on conventional DVD computer storage disks have been engraved (preferred to burned) on archival M-DISC™ DVD 4.7GB media: Millenniata, Inc. These disks are expected to last 1,000 years according to life tests performed by various organizations, See <https://www.mdisc.com/>. Such discs will be labeled with the suffix -M, for example #0004-M.

Thumb Dive

Envelope Designation

Some items are placed in envelopes identified as follows:

The designation refers only to the size of the envelope. There may be several different items each with unique numbers carrying the Envelope A designation. Boxes are unique, envelopes are not: there is only one Box A, but many envelopes labeled as A, B, or C.

The complexity of this project grew as it progressed. Effort was made to maintain at least a modicum of consistency. We apologize in advance for errors and anomalies. Some items will be difficult to find since there was no efficient way to store the many items in a logical order.

Notes:

- A: According to Jane Weber these caps were used by the Children's Choir circa 1960. There are 3 different styles: 1 small, 3 intermediate, and 6 large (with buttons).
- B: Sometime, probably in the Seventies or Eighties, St. Paul's member Jack Sanzenbacher made 8 or so cash boxes for the Women of St. Paul Rummage Sale. These were used for many years. The hinges began to fail and the boxes were replaced by metal cash boxes. Sometime before 2014 it was decided to sell these boxes in the Rummage Sale as memorabilia.

Two boxes were retained. In 2013 Ernie Lippert refurbished one of these boxes. The loose hinges were repaired by adding small washers to prevent the screw heads from passing through the holes in the hinges. In addition, the screw threads were coated with Hardman Epoxy before reseating them into the plywood. This raised the screw height on the inside of the box. Small circular depressions were sculpted in the hinge areas to allow the lid to close properly.
