Charles F. Vent, age 87 of Dr. McAuley Ct., Perrysburg, died Tuesday in his home. He was born in Chicago and attended the University of Chicago and Kenyon College. He worked in the field of heating and air conditioning as a salesman, sales engineer, mechanical designer and project engineer.
