## Retired Businessman Owned Stores In Rossford, Toledo

Harold S. Hall, 81, of 214 West Front St., Perrysburg, a retired Toledo businessman, died Sunday in St. Luke's Hospital.

Mr. Hall was owner of the former Reeder-Yant & Co. store, in Toledo, until 1955, and the Federated Store, in Rossford, which closed in 1966. He subsequently worked part-time at Kessler's Men's Store, Perrysburg, retiring in 1979.
