

## Banking, Mining, Hotel Executive

Henson Leland Jones, 62, of 535 East Front St., Perrysburg, a banking, mining, real estate, and hotel executive, died yesterday in Toledo Hospital.

Mr. Jones was a lifelong resident of the Toledo area.

He was graduated in 1921 from Scott High School, and earned a bachelor of science degree from Dartmouth College in 1926.

After graduation from college Mr. Jones became associated with the coal mining and real estate interests of his father, the late George M. Jones. He held executive positions with the various companies since then.

### Helped Form Bank

Mr. Jones was chairman of the board and president of the Commodore Perry Hotel Co., and vice president of the Cambria Mining Co.

He participated in organizing the Ohio Citizens Trust Co. in 1932; became a director of the bank in 1940, and served on its executive mortgage loan, and trust committees.

### Church Vestryman

Mr. Jones was a member of the Toledo Hospital board of trustees, Toledo Area Chamber of Commerce, Toledo Society for Crippled Children, Phi Gamma Delta fraternity, Rotary Club of Toledo, the Toledo Club, Carranor Hunt and Polo Club, and the Toledo Country Club.

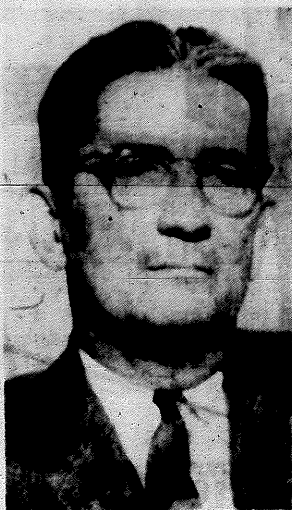
He previously was a vestryman at Trinity Episcopal Church.

He also served on the Toledo Community Chest Board and was a former board member and president of Maumee Valley Country Day School.
