

# Janet Hinz Arner

Retired English teacher, dean, assistant principal at Clay High

Mrs. Janet M. Hinz Arner, 84, formerly of Watova Road, a retired Clay High School teacher and assistant principal, died Wednesday in Colonial Nursing Home, where she lived the last three years.

A native Toledoan, Mrs. Arner earned her bachelor's degree in education at Ohio State University and her master's degree at the University of Toledo.

She spent her entire career at Clay High School, first as an English teacher, later as a counselor and dean of students, and finally as assistant principal. Mrs. Arner retired in 1974.

She was the widow of Dr. William Arner and was a member of the Toledo Club.
