

Maumee Woman Found Dead In Auto In Garage

Mrs. Leoda C. Strong, 61, of 432 West Broadway, Maumee, was found dead Thursday in a car in the garage of her home.

Dr. Louis Martin, deputy coroner, ruled the death a suicide, resulting from carbon monoxide poisoning.

Surviving are her husband, Fred B.; daughters, Mrs. Shirley Talbut, Mrs. Sharon Stolberg, and Mrs. Sydney Nichols,

and sisters, Mrs. Ethel Knott, Mrs. Katherine Shuman, and Mrs. Josephine Davis.

Private services will be at 11 a.m. Saturday in St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Maumee. The body will be in the Maison-Dardenne Mortuary, Maumee, after 7 tonight.
