Maumee Police Chief From 1914 To 1918

Mathias Dohr, a former Maumee police chief, died yesterday in the home of a grandson, Mayor John Henderson, Maumee, exactly three weeks after the death of his son, John Dohr, also a former Maumee police chief.

Mr. Dohr, 88, was a native of Tiffin, O., and had lived in Maumee 85 years. He was chief of police from 1914 to 1918 and after his son became chief, he became a night policeman. From 1922 to 1937 he was night watchman at the Lucas County Courthouse.

Other survivors include seven other grandchildren and eight great-grandchildren.

Services conducted by the Rev. R. Malcolm Ward, rector of St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Maumee, will be Monday at 2 p.m. in the Maison-Dardenne Funeral Home. Burial will be in Swan Creek Cemetery.
