Retired Railroad Agent, Ex-Manager In Insurance

Philip L. Unsinger, 60, a retired railroad agent and former insurance executive, died yesterday in Medical College Hospital.

Mr. Unsinger, of South Byrne Road, and formerly of Maumee, was an agent 12 years with the Toledo Terminal Railroad and 12 years with the Chessie System. During that time he also served as president of the employees union there.

Prior to that Mr. Unsinger, a graduate of Bowling Green State University, was involved in the insurance business nearly 16 years.

A native of Fremont, Mr. Unsinger started in the insurance business in 1958. He was a special agent and a supervisor before being named manager of the Toledo office of the American United Life Insurance Co. in 1966.

Two years later he was named by the firm as agency manager for the Toledo area. Mr. Unsinger also was an insurance agent with Prudential and Union Central Insurance companies 13 years, and a navy veteran of World War II.

Surviving are his sons, Eric and Bruce; brother, Richard, and sisters, Mrs. Muriel Markwith and Mrs. Winifred Nielson.

Services will be at 10 a.m. Tuesday in the Maison-Dardenne Mortuary, Maumee, where the body will be after 2 p.m. tomorrow.
