Executive Vice President Of Lamb Enterprises

Robert T. Guyton, 38, local banker and business executive, died Saturday night in Medical College Hospital, where he was taken after becoming ill in his home at 25101 West River Rd., Perrysburg.

Mr. Guyton was a senior vice president of Nevada National Bank, in Reno; executive vice president of Lamb Enterprises, Inc., and Lamb Communications, Inc., and a director of Seilon, Inc., all of Toledo, and Netter International, Ltd., of New York.

A 1960 engineering graduate of Yale University, Mr. Guyton received a master's degree in business administration from Harvard Business School in 1966. He was a lieutenant (j.g.) in the U.S. Navy.

Mr. Guyton was a member of the Toledo Club, Belmont Country Club, Carranor Hunt and Polo Club, and the Yale Club of New York City.

He was past president of the Yale Sailing Club, and was a former director of the Planned Parenthood League of Toledo and the Big Brothers of Northwestern Ohio.

Surviving are his wife, Priscilla; daughters, Melissa and Margaret; son, Robert E.; mother, Mrs. Margaret Guyton; sisters, Mrs. Carol Goodell, and brother, Richard Guyton.
